On January 1, 2021 the balance on our mortgage was \$1,071,711. As of April 4, 2022, the balance was \$548,346. This represents a **\$522,756** decrease since January 1, of 2021 as a result of budgeted mortgage payments, additional giving to reduce debt through the year, and gifts made toward campaign commitments.
