### Life at Massanutten

- **Today is Youth Sunday!** We are grateful for the prayer, time and gifts that have been offered to prepare and lead today's service.
- Last Sunday evening our confirmands, Ruth Rascoe and Riley Scheidt, were examined for membership by a team from the session. On May 22nd they will be received into membership during our worship service.
- Sunday morning education opportunities continue through May 22nd, the last day of our programming year. Adults are invited to gather at 9:00 am in room 117 (Simon Peter: Flawed But Faithful Disciple) or 119 (The Difficult Words of Jesus). At 9:30 am Children K through 5th grade are exploring the story of Abraham and God's Covenant with him. 6th and 7th graders are invited to join as youth helpers. And, parents who would like to connect for some fellowship and conversation are invited to gather at 9:30 on the lower level.
- Church Communications Update: Last week we changed the office email system. On January 1, 2021 the balance on our mortgage was \$1,010,711. As of April 24, 2022, the balance was \$504,292. This represents a **\$566,810** decrease since January 1, of 2021 as a result of budgeted mortgage payments, additional giving to reduce debt through the year, and gifts made toward campaign commitments.
