On January 1, 2021 the balance on our mortgage was \$1,010,711. As of April 24, 2022, the balance was \$504,292. This represents a \$566,810 decrease since January 1, of 2021 as a result of budgeted mortgage payments, additional giving to reduce debt through the year, and gifts made toward cam-
