This year's theme is **Blessed Be**; participants will explore what Jesus has to say in Matthew 5:1-11 through Bible study, recreation, art, music and the gift of fellowship and relationship building.

# **Children and Youth Corner**

**O.U.R. – Outreach, Understanding, Rejoicing – Hearts** is a short-term mission experience for churches and youth groups. Groups are housed in the Craigsville Presbyterian Church, which has full shower facilities. Throughout the week our youth and adult chaperones will:

- Prepare for their visit through a study of the culture of generational poverty and food insecurities
- Participate in and help lead in creative worship and devotion experiences during the week
- Plan and complete service work needed in the community
- Use the food pantry to understand how it supports those who need the extra support to alleviate hunger
