On January 1, 2021 the balance on our mortgage was \$1,071,111. As of September 21, 2022, our loan balance was \$383,815 - a decrease of \$687,296 in the last 20 months. Since the beginning of the Debt Reduction Campaign 12 months ago, \$566,920 has been paid on the mortgage. The decreases is a result of budgeted mortgage payments, additional giving to reduce debt through the year, and gifts made toward campaign commitments. To God be the Glory!
