On January 1, 2021, the balance on our mortgage was \$1,071,111. As of October 21, 2022, our loan balance was \$366,850 - a decrease of **\$704,261** in the last 23 months.

Since the Debt Elimination Campaign began in October 2021, \$583,915 has been paid on the mortgage as a result of budgeted mortgage payments, additional giving to reduce debt through the year, & gifts made toward campaign commitments. **To God be the Glory!**
