On January 1, 2021, the balance on our mortgage was \$1,071,111. As of December 23, 2022, our balance was \$259,253 - a decrease of **\$811,858** in the last 24 months.

Since the Debt Elimination Campaign began in October 2021, \$691,512 has been paid on the mortgage as a result of budgeted mortgage payments, additional giving to reduce debt through the year, & gifts made toward campaign commitments. **To God be the Glory!**
