On January 1, 2021, the balance on our mortgage was \$1,071,111. As of January 25, 2023, our balance was \$238,335- a decrease of **\$832,773** in the last 24 months.

Since the Debt Elimination Campaign began in September 2021, \$712,427 has been paid on the mortgage as a result of budgeted mortgage payments, additional giving to reduce debt through the year, & gifts made toward campaign commitments. To God be the Glory!
