- There will be an Ash Wednesday service at 6:00 pm this week which will include the imposition of ashes. Pastors Ann and Keith will also be offering "Ashes to Go" between 7:00—8:30 am that morning under the awning near the main entrance. For those unable to attend in person, the service will be livestreamed; you may pick up a container of ashes in the entry way on Tuesday evening.
- Lenten Studies will be offered throughout the next 6 weeks:

<u>Thursdays at 11:00</u> am (church) and 7 pm (Zoom) Pastors Keith and Ann will lead groups that will follow our Lenten theme: 'Seeking: Honest Questions for Deeper Faith,' beginning this Thursday, February 23rd. Each Sunday at 9:00 am the Sunday school classes will be using 'An Acceptable Fast' to move through the season, beginning next Sunday, February 26th.
