On January 1, 2021, the balance on our mortgage was \$1,071,111. As off December 20, 2023, our balance was \$42,488 - a decrease of **\$1,028,623**.

Since the Debt Elimination Campaign began on September 1, 2021, \$908,277 has been paid on the mortgage as a result of budgeted mortgage payments, additional giving to reduce debt through the year and gifts made toward campaign commitments. **To God be the Glory!**
