# Life at Massanutten

- Blanket the World with Love—Offering envelopes for the Blankets+ Offering are in the chair racks. A gift of \$10 will purchase a blanket for a person or family in need. Hebrews 13:16 reminds us, "And don't forget to do good and share with those in need."
- **MPC's Hunger Ministries** continue to provide food to families in our area. During the month of November, the *Food Pantry* served 26 families which included 88 individuals, 34 of whom were under the age of 18. *Blessings in a Bag* is currently providing 62 bags of food to children at South River Elementary School each week. Thank you for supporting these ministries with your time, gifts and prayers.

On January 1, 2021, the balance on our mortgage was \$1,071,111. As of December 20, 2023, our balance was \$42,488 - a decrease of **\$1,028,623**.

Since the Debt Elimination Campaign began on September 1, 2021, \$908,277 has been paid on the mortgage as a result of budgeted mortgage payments, additional giving to reduce debt through the year and gifts made toward campaign commitments. **To God be the Glory!**
