He is the Vice President of the Ethiopian Evangelical Church Mekane Yesus, the Ethiopian denomination with whom the PCUSA is in a long-standing relationship for mission and ministry. He is here to attend the annual Ethiopia Mission Network conference being held in Lancaster, PA. Rev. Tariku is the previous President of the Illubabor Bethel Synod, who is the partner of our own Shenandoah Presbytery. He served the synod as President for 8 years before moving to the church's central offices in Addis Ababa. Rev. Tariku lives in Addis Ababa with his wife and two teenage children.
