

# MPC Supports the "Building a Place for All" Campaign!



The Session has approved a \$75,000 commitment for the Massanetta Springs' "Building a Place for All" campaign. Over the next few weeks you'll learn more and have a chance to participate in the campaign. The distribution of our commitment includes:

- \$25,000 from our ministry budget. \$5,000 per year for five years, and will be in addition to our regular support of Massanetta's ministry and program.
