God is here! As we your people meet to offer praise and prayer, may we find in fuller measure what it is in Christ we share. Here, as in the world around us, all our varied skills and arts wait the coming of the Spirit into open minds and hearts.

Life at Massanutten

Throughout the 2024-2025 program year, we are exploring what it means to deepen our connectedness to God, to one other and to the world. We have been doing this by focusing for a season on traditional discipleship practices: worship (September), education (November), generosity, prayer and service.

The first words in Psalm 24 bear testimony to God's creative power and love: 'The earth is the Lord's and all that is in it, the world, and those who live in it.' In this third practice of discipleship—Generosity— we will explore what it means to be recipients of God's kindness, goodness and hospitality—in the abundant way it is given to us. We will consider what God invites us to do with these gifts, and we will prayerfully ask God to reveal to us something new about how we live into generosity in faithful ways.

- Topics for Adult Sunday School
 - Faithful Conversations has begun a study of the book *Necessary Risks: Challenges Privileged People Need to Face*, by Rev. Dr. Teri McDowell Ott. Teri is the editor of the Presbyterian Outlook magazine. She and her family are friends of our congregation.
 - Covenant Class has begun studying *Enough: God's Blessings in Abundance*, from the PC(USA)'s Being Reformed series.
- Last Spring, we launched the new **Oak Tree Capital Reserve Fund** and **Acorn Endowment Fund to** help our ministry continue to grow, today and in the future. Here are the balances in our Legacy Funds as of December 31, 2024:
 - Acorn Endowment Fund: \$17,664
 - Oak Tree Capital Reserve Fund: \$79,293
- Many thanks to all who have pledged or made a gift to **Massanetta's Building A Place For All campaign**. Our church's total so far is almost \$100,000! Wow! Massanetta is just \$325,000 short of the initial goal of \$4.5 million. There's still time to close this gap by the board's goal of June 1.
